


Final Pathological Diagnosis

Clothing: The victim was wearing a white long-sleeve, button up collared shirt. Underneath that the victim was wearing a large white t-shirt. He was wearing black socks, black pants, boxer shorts, and black dress shoes. His red tie was loosened around his neck and his collar was bent in place.

External Examination: The body was a normally developed white male, consistently appearing to be the age of 26. The weight of the body was 180 pounds. The body is cold and unembalmed. Lividity is fixed in the distal portions of the limbs. The eyes are open. Evidence of blunt force trauma to the back of the head with an irregularly shaped object.

Evidence of Injury: Hair matted on the back of the head, along with the amount of blood suggests that the victim was hit several times with irregularly shaped object at a high velocity.

Evidence of Recent Medical Treatment: None

Other Identifying Features: Tattoo of "I Love You Mom" on upper right shoulder.

Internal Examination:

The amount of blood and the number of contusions to the back of the head suggests that the heart continued pumping after the victim was struck and death was not instantaneous. Victim died due to blood loss and contusions to the occipital lobe of the cerebrum.

All other systems are undamaged and without contusions.
