Special tips for detectives assigned to work on 'Deathboat' case.

1. Check all interviews for revealing remarks - someone may know too much and give the game away.
2. Examine the menu card carefully and look at photographs for extra clues.
3. Watch out for clues that may lead you in the wrong direction. This is called a 'red herring'.
4. Remember the old saying: *The love of money is the root of all evil*. If money was the motive, who knew about it and how?
5. Take **detailed notes** in your Crime Log.
6. Fill in your **Suspect, Motive, Opportunity, and Ability Chart**
7. Write a **recreation essay** on what happened on the night in question. Use **evidence** to back up your story wherever possible.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR INVESTIGATIONS AT SEA:

- ✍ A luxury motor yacht avoids obstacles at night or in fog by radar and can steer its own course by autopilot.
- ✍ A fast vessel travels at about 18 knots, which is equivalent to 20 miles or 32 kilometres per hour.
- ✍ Ships communicate by two-way radio.
